Money: You Have it all Backwards!

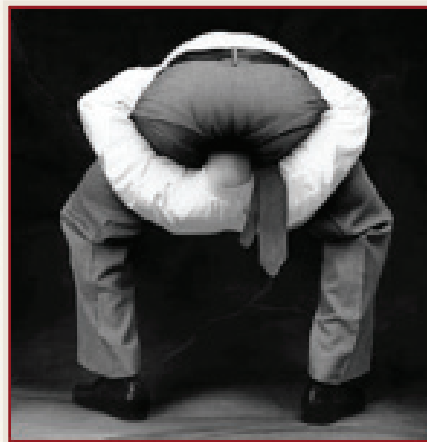
Okay, I'll do the best I can here in 3-1/2 minutes:
